All our bikes are fitted with comfortable gel saddles (with a seat post diameter between 27.2 and 31.4 mm). Please note that GPS is not a standard fitting on our bikes.

STAGE 1: COPENHAGEN - KØGE APPROX, 65 KM

Special advice about the route

Most of the first stage will take you along 'Køge Bay', with the Baltic Sea in sight at all times. The entirely car-free national park Amager Fælled (Amager Common) will impress you with its scenery, and art enthusiasts should definitely take the time to visit the Arken Museum of Modern Art. Køge is one of the oldest cities in Denmark and is located directly on the coast, its white sandy beaches will tempt you to take a refreshing dip.

0.0 km	From Hotel Absalon , turn right onto the street Istedgade and follow it until its end. In front of the train station building, turn left onto the cycle path on Reventlowsgade and continue until you reach the crossroads. Turn right here and continue on Vesterbrogade.
0.7 km	At Tivoli amusement park, turn right onto H.C. Andersens Boulevard and follow it straight ahead over the Langebro bridge and onto Amager Boulevard.
1.8 km	After the bridge, take the first right turn onto Thorshavnsgade. At the end of the street, go right and then after 70 m, turn left onto Islands Bygge and continue on this street. Attention: Use the bike path on the right-hand side of the street at all times!
3.8 km	At the water park, turn right and, after a short left-hand bend, continue straight ahead past the residential tower blocks and follow the cycle path signposts for Route 6 (white number with a red background on a blue sign). This will lead you along the riverbank and through the national park Amager Fælled.
5.4 km	Go right after the small footbridge and then after approx. 50 m left again, following Route 6 towards Køge under the bridges and straight ahead along the riverbank.
9.6 km	After crossing under the motorway, take a sharp left up to the bridge and at the top, take another sharp left and follow the signposts for Route 6 over the bridge towards Hundige.

11.1 km	Coming from the bridge, turn right to go through the underpass and immediately after, go left and continue following the main direction of the cycle path to Hundige.
13.9 km	After the small footbridge, continue left. Shortly afterwards, go left at the fork in the road and after the underpass, keep to the right. Go left at the next fork and through another underpass, then turn left up onto the dam. Cross the embankment to continue on Svingelstien.
18.0 km	Continue following Route 6 past the harbour restaurant and keep to the left after approx. 300 m.
19.8 km	Cross the street and turn left onto the cycle path towards Arken.
20.4 km	Turn right in front of the Arken Museum of Modern Art and continue to the right towards Hundige Strandpark.
22.4 km	Turn right and go around Greve Marina.
24.2 km	Take a sharp right and after around 600 m, turn right again to follow the street Jens Frobergsyej to the main road.
24.9 km	At the main road Hundige Strandvej, turn right and proceed to the zebra crossing. Cross over here and continue to the left on the cycle path along the street, always following the main direction of the cycle route.

31.7 km	At the roundabout, take the first exit (cycle path sign Route 9 in the direction of Køge) and continue along Karlslunde Mosevej until its end.
33.7 km	Turn right onto Karlslunde Landevej in the direction of Tastrup and after around 500 m, turn left onto Hovedgaden (40 km/h zone) and continue following its course.
35.0 km	After the last house on the left site, turn left onto Hastrupwejen (Route 9) and at the next fork, continue to the left.
40.7 km	Turn left in front of the church in Solrød, then turn right into the next street and shortly afterwards left again, following Route 9 through the village.
41.3 km	After the underpass, continue to the left
42.5 km	Turn right, then after 200 m turn left and follow the cycle path past Jersie Hallen.
43.7 km	In Jersie, turn left and follow Route 9 towards Køge.
45.0 km	Continue to the right towards Køge.
46.0 km	Keep to the right and go over the railway crossing and on through Lille Skensved, After the left- hand bend, turn left onto Ølbyvej, and after approx. 300 m, turn right onto Hejelsevej.

48.8 km	At the church in Højelse, turn left onto Dalkærgårdsvej, continue until the end of the street and then continue to the right.
50.9 km	Turn left at the end of the priority road and straight away take the next right, again onto Ølbyvej. Follow this towards the centre of Køge.
51.7 km	Go straight over the bridge to cross the highway and continue on Route 9.
54.9 km	Go straight ahead over the crossroads and continue on Vestergade (Route 9).
55.5 km	At the end of the street, turn right, and after the small bridge take the third exit off the roundabout (Strandvejen) and continue until the railway crossing (Attention: Push your bike here). Then continue until the main road and bear slightly right, then at the end of the street slightly left. After a few metres, Hotel Comwell Køge Strand will be on the left.

STAGE 2: KØGE - NÆSTVED APPROX. 60 KM

Special advice about the route

Today you will say goodbye to the coast. The route will bring you inland to pass through southern Zealand. Magnificent green scenery with vast meadows and forests will accompany you the whole way. The medieval townscape of Næstved with its old town houses will entice you to take a stroll. Alternatively, you could go on an excursion to the rococo-style Gavnø Castle.

).0 Km	Start in Køge at Hotel Comwell Køge Strand. From the hotel car park, turn left onto Strandvejen and follow the cycle path along the coast.
2.5 km	Turn right onto Billesborgvej.
4.7 km	At the roundabout, take the third exit towards Vedskølle. From now on, you will follow the cycle path signs for Route 561
6.6 km	At the end of the street in Vedskølle, turn left towards Vallø, then after approx. 300 m, turn right towards Endeslev.
9.8 km	Continue to the right towards Endesiev.
11.8 km	In Endesley, turn right onto Lerskovyej in the direction of Vráby.
14.7 km	In Vråby, turn right onto Skovkildevej.
17.0 km	At the end of the priority road, turn left towards Kæderup, then after 600 m at the end of the street, turn right towards Kæderup.

18.6 km	At the fork in the road, continue to the right (no longer towards Kæderup) and after 1 km at the end of the street, follow Route 56 to the left onto Rødestræde.
20.2 km	Turn left towards Nyby.
22.3 km	Continue to the right towards Tågerup.
23.9 km	Continue straight ahead at the crossroads towards Viverup.
25.8 km	Turn left and follow Route 56 on Lergårdsvej.
26.8 km	Just after the left-hand bend, turn right onto Bødkerstræde.
28.2 km	At the end of the street, turn left towards Faxe and then after approx. 150 m, turn right again to keep following Route 56.
30.4 km	Continue to the right on Lystrupvej.
32.2 km	At the end of the priority road, cross the main road and turn right onto the cycle path to continue on Route 56 towards Præsto.
32.5 km	From the cycle path, turn left onto Nymarksvej in the direction of Kongsted.

34.2 km	In Kongsted, turn left towards Hyllede.
34.8 km	Turn right towards Eskilstrup.
36.5 km	Turn left towards Leestrup, and after 150 m turn right again towards Leestrup.
38.1 km	Turn right towards Stavnstrup, then continue to the left at the next fork in the road.
40.0 km	Turn right towards Stavnstrup.
40.7 km	Turn left onto Hovskovvej.
41.5 km	Turn right (from now on you will continue on Route 54) and after approx. 150 m, turn right again.
42.6 km	Cross the main road and continue straight ahead.
44.6 km	Turn left towards Everdrup.
45.2 km	In front of the church in Everdrup, continue to the right. Just after the church, turn right again towards Næstved.
45.7 km	Turn left onto Flintemosevej in the direction of Bøgesø.

48.8 km	In Bøgesø, turn left onto Bøgesøvej and follow this street.
52.4 km	At the end of the priority road, continue to the right in the direction of Næstved.
53.9 km	Turn right onto Næstelsø Præstemark and continue towards Næstelsø.
55.6 km	Turn left towards Næstved.
57.8 km	After the left-hand bend in Rønnebæk, turn right at the church onto Gækhøjvej and after a little over 200 m, continue left onto Præsteengen. At the end of the street, bear slightly right through the barrier onto Laugstien, following Route 54.
60.0 km	Go through the underpass, then take a sharp right up to the bridge. Turn right over the bridge and then turn off right to follow Præstøvej.
51.5 km	At the traffic lights, go straight over the crossroads onto Østergade and follow the road markings to the right to pass by the church Sankt Mortens Kirke.
51.9 km	After the church, turn left into the pedestrian area (cycling is allowed) and continue to the end of Riddergade. Cross the street and Hotel Kirstine will be directly in front of you.

STAGE 3: NÆSTVED - KORSØR APPROX. 65 KM

Special advices about the route

Today you will continue onwards to the West and the Great Belt. You will quickly reach the small coastal town of Karrebæksminde. At Enø, the stunning sandy beach will entice you to sunbathe. Following the coast at times, you will pass through the harbour town of Skælskør before reaching today's goal - Korsør. This charming harbour town offers a diverse and lively culture scene.

0,0 Km	Starting in Næstved from Hotel Kirstine, turn right onto Slagkildevej and continue straight ahead
	over the crossroads. 30 m after the crossroads, follow the bend to your right.
0.4 km	Turn left onto Fabriksvej and follow cycle path Route 8.
1.1 km	Turn right onto Engyej and continue until the roundabout. Just before the roundabout, turn left onto the cycle path along Grimstrupvej and follow this for now.
2.9 km	Turn right and go through the underpass. Take the second exit on the bicycle roundabout and go through the underpass again, then follow the cycle path along the street.
7.1 km	Pass the roundabout, staying on the cycle path.
10.2 km	At the end of the cycle path in Karrebæksminde, continue to the right on the street Brosvinget in the direction of Stranden.
10.4 km	Turn right onto Langelinie in the direction of Smålandshavet (Route 51), and shortly afterwards pass to the right of the tennis court. Follow the path through the housing estate parallel to the beach.

11.7 km	Go left on the meadow path past the farmyard. Continue to the right on Vesterhavevej, then go left at the fork in the road onto Brøndagervej.
13.2 km	Continue left towards Karrebækstorp on Route 51 (Route 8 and 51 are identical until Skælskør and the bike path signs will alternate!).
14.7 km	Continue to the left towards Klinteby.
18.9 km	Continue to the right towards Spjellerup.
21.8 km	Just before the main street, turn left onto Diegardsvej.
24.4 km	After entering Skafterup, continue straight into the village, then turn left to continue towards Bisserup.
26.4 km	Just after entering Bisserup, turn right and follow the street through the village. At the end of the street, turn right towards Holsteinborg and continue through the villages of Ørslev and Vedskølle.
39.0 km	After the church in Magleby, turn left towards Stigsnæs. Approx. 700 m later, turn right towards Borreby, then cross the main road and continue straight ahead (Route 8).
41.1 km	Go past Borreby castle and just after it, turn right towards Skælskør.

42.9 km	For now, follow the cycle path signs for Route 8 though Skælskør.
43,9 km	Go left over the bridge and continue on Vestergade. After approx. 200 m, turn right on Route 8 towards Korsør C.
44.4 km	Just before the main road, follow the cycle path signposts to the right and through the underpass. After the underpass, go left up to the street and continue along it on the cycle path.
45.4 km	The cycle path changes to the other side of the road.
46.9 km	Turn left onto Rennebjergvej in the direction of Boeslunde.
49.8 km	Turn left towards V.Bøgebjerg, continuing on Route 8.
54.0 km	Turn right onto Lille Egedevej.
55.2 km	Turn left onto the cycle path (Route 8) next to the street in the direction of Korsør.
57.9 km	→ Guests staying at the hotel <u>Comwell Klarskovgaard</u> turn left here and follow the signposts to the hotel.
57.9 km	→ To get to the centre of Korsør, stop following Route 8 and instead cycle straight ahead beside the main road Skovej towards Korsør.

STAGE 4: KORSØR - SORØ/SURROUNDING AREA APPROX. 50 KM

Special advice about the route

Today, you should make a short stop in Trelleborg along the way. You can learn about life and culture in the Viking age by visiting a huge ring fort, built around 900 A.C., with a modern museum. Upon arrival in Sorø, it is worth visiting the monastery. The old 12th century abbey church was modelled on the Cistercian abbey of Fontaney.

From Hotel Comwell Klarskovgaard, start by going back to the main road along the same way as the day before. Turn left onto the cycle path next to the main road and follow this along the priority road to the centre until the third roundabout (Description of stage 3 starting from 58.3 km).

From Hotel Comwell Korsør, start by going left along Ørnumvej for about 100 m until the roundabout.

0,0 Km	From Hotel Comwell Klarskovgaard , start by going back to the main road along the same way as the day before. Turn left onto the cycle path next to the main road and follow this along the priority road into the town centre.
4.9 km	Follow the priority road Mathiesensvej to the right into the town centre.
6.1 km	At this roundabout and the next one, take the first exit each time.
7.5 km	At the roundabout, take the second exit going out of the town to the North on Tarnborgvej (highway E20), then pass under the highway and take the second exit on the next roundabout.
8.9 km	Just after the bridge, turn right over the train tracks and onto the cycle path (cycle path signs for Route 6)
10.6 km	Turn right onto Stibjergvej and follow this street through Svenstrup.
11.4 km	Turn left towards Frølunde and continue along the priority road.
16.6 km	At the end of the priority road, turn right towards Korsør, and shortly after turn left towards Forlev, following Route 6.

18.7 km	Continue to the left towards Gl. Forley.
19.7 km	Continue to the right on the priority road.
21.8 km	Go left towards Slagelse and after 500 m, bear slightly right towards Slots Bjergby. At each fork in
24.6 km	After the barrier, continue straight ahead, following Route 6 through Slagelse,
25.1 km	Turn right onto Idagårdve) and continue following Route 6 on the cycle path.
27.0 km	Approx. 200 m after the underpass, turn right then right again, then immediately go left around the signposting for Route 6!).
27.6 km	After the underpass, follow the street to the right up to the street and go left along it. At the roundabout, cross over to the right side of the street. Take the second exit and continue along the
29.4 km	At the roundabout, take the third exit, again heading towards Næstved.
31.5 km	Turn left towards Bøstrup. After 400 m take a sharp left, again toward Bøstrup.

33.2 km	Follow Route 6 to the right.
34.1 km	After the right-hand bend, continue to the left towards Lynge Eskilstrup.
37.6 km	Turn right towards Lynge Eskilstrup.
38.7 km	Turn left towards Eskilstrup and continue following Route 6.
40.9 km	Take a sharp left towards Stenstrup. From now on, you will continue on Route 7.
43.3 km	Turn left towards Grøfte.
44.4 km	Go right at the fork in the road towards Grøfte.
46.1 km	Take a sharp right towards Borød Flinterup.
49.1 km	Turn left onto Borødvej, following Route 7.
50.6 km	At the end of the priority road, you will leave Route 7 and turn right towards Sorø.
52.4 km	Turn left onto Abildvej and follow the signposting to Comwell Sorø.
53.1 km	Go left around the bend and after 100 m, Hotel Comwell Sorø will be on the right-hand side.

STAGE 5: SORØ/SURROUNDING AREA - ROSKILDE APPROX. 65 KM

Special advices about the route

Today you will again be accompanied by green meadows and charming little villages. Via Ledreborg Castle in Lejre and the Bay of Roskilde, you will reach the town which gives the bay its name. The town's cathedral will be visible from afar, welcoming you to Roskilde. Since the beginning of the 15th century, this cathedral has been the preferred burial site for the Danish royal family, and since 1995 it is also part of UNESCO world heritage. It is also worth visiting the Viking ship museum.

0.0 km	Starting from Hotel Comwell Sorø, go back to the main road Slagelsevej and turn left onto the cycle path next to the street (number 150). Follow it for approx. 13 km, through the centre of Sorø and on towards Ringsted.
13 km	Turn left towards Bringstrup. From here, you will follow cycle path Route 6.
14.5 km	Shortly after the church in Bringstrup, turn right and follow the street.
15.7 km	In Ørslev U. Skoven, turn right towards Haraldsted, following Route 6
17.4 km	At the end of the priority street, turn left towards Haraldsted.
20.4 km	Turn right on Route 6 and follow the course of the street through Haraldsted. At the end of the village, bear left towards Valsølille.
29,4 km	Turn left towards Hvalsø and continue on Route 6.
32.2 km	Turn right towards Smidstrup.
34.4 km	Take a sharp right towards Lerbjerg on Route 6.

35.1 km	Turn left on Route 6.
36.7 km	Continue to the left at the fork in the road.
38.7 km	Bear left into the 30 km/h zone, after approx. 150 m bear right onto the priority road leading into the town centre, staying on Route 5. At the roundabout, take the second exit, then after the railway underpass, take the first exit off the next roundabout.
43.5 km	Continue to the right on Route 6 towards Roskilde.
44.4 km	Attention: on the right-hand bend, first go straight ahead onto the side-road, and after a few metres go right at the fork in the road to continue.
47.1 km	Back on the asphalted road, bear left past the club building of the golf course.
49.1 km	At the STOP sign, turn left onto the cycle path and continue in the direction of Gl. Lejre.
49.7 km	Upon entering GI. Leire, go right to cross the car park and continue on Route 6.
50.5 km	Turn right, go over the small footbridge and shortly afterwards continue to the left.
52.6 km	Turn right and follow Route 6 towards Roskilde.

53.4 km	Bear left to follow Route 6 through the underpass, then through Svogerslev to Roskilde.
57.8 km	In Roskilde, turn left at the traffic lights onto Fæiledvej and at the next roundabout, take the second exit onto Heiligkorsvej. Follow Route 6 to Roskilde Cathedral.
59.2 km	Turn left before the cathedral and pass by it, following Route 86 for now.
59.9 km	Take the second exit off the roundabout, marked O1n. After approx. 400 m at the next roundabout, take the third exit towards Roskilde N and follow this street.
62.5 km	After the traffic lights, turn right onto Vestre Kirkevej and after around 500 m, Hotel Comwell Roskilde will be on the right-hand side.

STAGE 6: ROSKILDE - COPENHAGEN APPROX. 40 KM

Special advices about the route

The last stage brings you directly back to your starting point, the Danish capital Copenhagen. From Albertslund onwards, you will use the 'bicycle superhighway' C99 which will bring you right into the city centre with almost no traffic. In the afternoon, you will still have enough time to explore the city. While strolling through the streets, you can think back to all the fabulous sights from your bicycle tour through Zealand.

0.0 km	Starting from Hotel Comwell Roskilde, turn left onto Vestre Kirkevej,
0.6 km	Turn right onto Frederiksborgvej and after approx. 500 m, turn left towards Hillerød.
1.6 km	Turn right onto Koldekildevej in the direction of Agerup.
3.3 km	At the end of the priority road, turn left towards Agerup.
5.7 km	Turn right towards Agerup and follow the priority road through the village.
8.3 km	Turn left towards Hvedstrup.
10.2 km	After the church in Hvedstrup, turn right and then straight away left to continue towards Sengeløse.
12.3 km	At the end of the priority road, go right to continue towards Sengeløse.
13.6 km	Turn right again towards Sengeløse.
14.9 km	Turn right before the church in Sengeløse, then go left alongside the pond. After the pond, keep to the left and only turn right towards Vridsløsemagie after the petrol station.

15.8 km	At the end of the village, continue left towards Vridsløsemagle.
18.5 km	After passing through Vridsløsemagle, turn left here towards Kroopedal.
19.7 km	Turn right and after about 800 m, cross the street and continue straight ahead past the barrier.
20.7 km	Bear right and follow the cyclé path through the highway underpass. From now on, you will follow the signposts for C99 in the direction of Vesterport C.
Vesterport t	ark's first 'bicycle superhighway' and goes from Albertslund right into the centre of Copenhagen to rain station. (Signposts with white C on a red background, and sometimes markings on the ground rrows on a red background.)
21.2 km	Take a sharp left and circle around the football fields, then after around 300 m, turn left away from the fields. Follow the cycle path past Albertslund Stadium.
22.3 km	At the fork in the road, bear left through the underpass and at the next fork in the road, bear right to pass by the round playing field, following the signs for C99.
22.6 km	Bear right to cross over the small square and continue on Trippendalstien.

35.6 km	Go straight ahead at the crossroads (pay attention to the bicycle traffic lights). After approx. 100 m, go left over the street and continue following the cycle path C99.

36.0 km Coming from the cycle path, go left onto Cykelgad Zone.

36.8 km From the cycle path, continue to the right on Thorvaldsensvej C99.

38.3 km Route C99 ends here.

Turn right from Kampmannsgade onto Vester Farimagsgade and follow this street through the apartment tower underpass, then go straight ahead at the next crossroads and turn right onto Istedgade at the train station.

After 150 m, Hotel Absalon will be on the left-hand side.

SHORT TRAVEL GUIDE



COPENHAGEN

Copenhagen is the capital and most populous city of Denmark. Copenhagen is situated on the eastern coast of the island of Zealand; another small portion of the city is located on Amager, and is separated from Malmö, Sweden, by the strait of Øresund. The Øresund Bridge connects the two cities by rail and road.

Tourism is a major contributor to Copenhagen's economy, attracting visitors due to the city's harbor, cultural attractions and award-winning restaurants. Since 2009, Copenhagen has been one of the fastest growing metropolitan destinations in Europe.

Apart from being the national capital, Copenhagen also serves as the cultural hub of Denmark and wider Scandinavia. Since the late 1990s, it has undergone a transformation from a modest Scandinavian capital into a metropolitan city of international appeal in the same league as Barcelona and Amsterdam.

KØGE

Køge is a seaport on the coast of Køge Bugt (Bay of Køge) 39 km southwest of Copenhagen. It is the principal town and seat of Køge Municipality, Region Sjælland, Denmark.

The natural harbor and strategic location have given Køge a long history as a market town. Today, that past is evident in a well-preserved old town center with many half-timbered houses.

ROSKILDE

Roskilde, located 30 km (19 mi) west of Copenhagen on the Danish island of Zealand, is the main city in Roskilde Municipality.

Roskilde has a long history, dating from the pre-Christian Viking Age. Its UNESCO-listed Gothic cathedral, now housing 39 tombs of the Danish monarchs, was completed in 1275, becoming a focus of religious influence until the Reformation.

The cathedral and the Viking Ship Museum, which contains the well-preserved remains of five 11th-century ships, attract more than 100,000 visitors annually. In addition to its internationally recognized tourist attractions and its annual rock festival, Roskilde is popular with shoppers thanks to its two centrally located pedestrian streets complete with restaurants, cafés, and a variety of shops.

ROSKILDE FJORD

Roskilde Fjord is the fjord north of Roskilde, Denmark. It is a long branch of the Isefjord.

During the Viking time around 1000 AD the people of Roskilde decided to sink a number of their ships in the fjord at Skuldelev in order to prevent the Vikings from coming in and raiding. Originally five were discovered; but while extending the museum that houses these finds another nine were uncovered.
